ISLE OF WIGHT COURTHOUSE COMPLEX



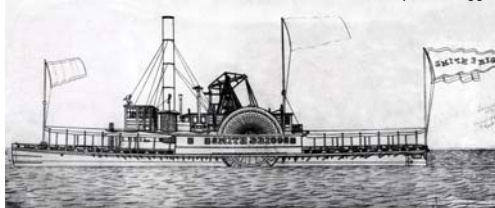

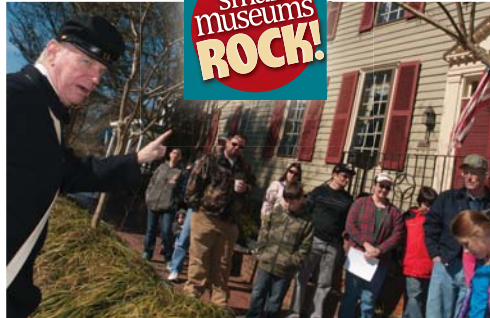
BATTLE OF SMITHFIELD
