## **November 8, 1945**

Dear Bro,

Received your texter of Oct 27th Tuesday and we were so glad to get it even though Bobbie has been reading hers to us or telling us the news; it was good to have one from you. I do feel guilty for I have fullen down on writing my self; for three weeks I have been house cleaning painting woodwork, stretching curtains and doing a general cleaning and I am not strough with it get I am doing it a lone and have to stop to cook and Leed chickens so I don't get a long very fast. I had a man to do most of the pointer so that was a big help. I hope to enjoy it ( a while after I finish for it has been a long time since it has been cleaned like this. Dad wrote to you a few weeks ago so I didn't write that week and it has been several weeks since I've written. Tuess you have gotten Dado letter by mor The is very anxious to hear from your, from your letter you hadn't gotten hid but you both were writing on the vame subject

That is farming. Dad is very anxious for you to come home and work before you attemp to brey for he has most every thing to farm with and you can get started before you try and too the realises that it is Imost to much for him dlove and so far he doesn't know how much help he will have another year. Smith the white milk man is leaving the first of Dec and he hasn't no one in his place get. Title Edward left some time ago and I strink the family is leaving for Dad told him he wouldn't have any bland for him next year. Labor is still very scarce. I know Vyou and Bobbie would rather get settle down but may be this would be butter like sad said for a year or two anyway and if you all should do this I will be glad to share the house with you so you all evuld be to yourselves I know you both would rather be to your selves and I am not trying to advise you but is you want it I could spare you as much as three rooms by making a kitchen out of the porch room. we are planning on making it larger anyway have wanted to do it for some time Had

thought may be we would make it into a down stairs pathroom or something it is too small as it is to be anual good for any thing. I am willing to do any thing that would make it convient for you all so you could be to gether until you could all could look around and sed what you wanted and what you would like to clo. I haven't mention this to Bobbie yet for I haven't see her since I have thought o) ilis. She was here Lund ay but we hadn't other your letter them. I know she had rather go to her self and who wouldn't but if you all want to do this I will be too glad to help you out as much as I can I will talk to Bobbie about it when she comes again. I know this isn't what she wants to do, but may be she wouldn't mind for a while. Frank minton, wife and child was out to see us to night. They are tiving with Lucy and Trank is working with Jeane I don't know for how tong as he is getting pay from the army with Dec. I heard and wasn't taking a job until after them Had a letter from his triday and he said he had a letter from you and enjoyed it so much

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He said he knew he was needed at home much more than he was over there Said he didn't know when he would get home. Joung says The same thing. Dad had his cows tested a week ango for IB and hange and out of 146; 46 reacted with bungs and 6 suspent no J.B. This will cut them down but Dad was planing on cutting them down this winter any way but like will take out several of this test. He is picking corn this week with mo Bealis picker; he has about 150 bblo after filling toth silos. This is the first time in several years that we have had any over to put in the crib. Haven't pushed any peanuts get waiting on mr Beale to funish his. Peanits is falling short with lots I people; not so many made this year Dad doesn't think his crop is short but you can't tell until ituy are pucked. you should have two more tropes before long I thing that box you got was apart of the things you request some time a go & slill have some more to send as soon as I can get it If I amt a box of speead + snayamine and a cake in one in Oct on the 8th.

9 November 1945 Furth, Germany Dear Dad, Reciend your letter of 23 oct. a few days ago and was very glad indeed to hear from you. I wanted to ansur it before now but shortly after of named it of was transferred of am now Commanding Officer of the 2312 AMA Lavel light Bon which is supposed to lave him for the states sometime in the mar future, promobil there are no further changes and of must say the anny ear usually find some reason for changing things. I hope they let us go nome this time. I have 1150 men and 42 officies and mine in the middle of transfiring men around now so we eve pretty busy.
